A. What happened to the Austro-Hungarian Empire? Be specific about the region.
B. How do you think Hungarians reacted to the end of WWI? What might they be thinking or feeling?
2. Read the following excerpt about "Jews in Eastern Europe" In 1920, influenced by antisemitic student movements and conservative Christian circles, the National Assembly passed the first "Jewish Law" in post–World War I Europe, the so-called <i>numerus clausus</i> law (Article XXV; 1920). While Jews were not mentioned explicitly and the law employed categories of nationality and race, it was aimed principally at Jews (who until then had never been defined legally in such terms). The <i>numerus clausus</i> placed a ceiling of 6 percent (corresponding to the percentage of Jews in the general population) on the percentage of Jewish students allowed in institutes of higher education.
